Description du stage / Position Description:	<p>Project Description:</p> <p>This project will support the work of the Dududu Youth Club (DYC) and the Dududu Drop-In Centre (DDIC) in Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa. The DYC aims to enhance leadership and life skills for youth in the Dududu community in an effort to improve health and overall socioeconomic outcomes. In addition, this project will increase the capacity of the Centre's food security and home-based care programs as well as the women's craft co-operative through organizational skill building. The intern will do this by crafting activities and workshops centered around two critical themes: HIV/AIDS and environmental stewardship.</p> <p>Position Description:</p> <p>The internship will build local organization capacity by creating motivation, exemplifying leadership and by addressing the community needs for greater youth involvement, literacy, and informal education. The intern's program will encourage community literacy on HIV and environmental degradation and the importance of informal education. This internship opportunity is led by the Canadian charity LetsStopAIDS.</p> <p>The intern will host HIV/AIDS and environmental-themed workshops and presentations that will emphasize: a) testing, diagnosis, prevention and treatment of HIV as well as other basics of health promotion; and b) the environment's importance to one's health and community. They will mobilize Dududu youth within the context of the DYC to attend workshops and planned activities, then take on the position of a positive role model in encouraging and engaging with them.</p> <p>Upon accepting the internship role, applicants will be encouraged to raise</p>
